Glover did not begin her career as an artist. After receiving an MBA from Harvard Business School, she served as an international consultant in strategy, industry best practices, and marketing communications. In the mid-1990s, she shifted to full-time work as a mixed-media artist and professional graphic designer. "Lurking all the while within and finally bursting forth," she says, "was a growing desire to realign my earlier studies in visual arts."

"Wave patterns, driven by wind, water, and gravity have entranced us humans throughout history. We never seem to get tired of watching them as they shift, pass, and arise anew. They respond to the forces that create them and may leave traces of their movement – think of sand patterns shaped by waves, cloud landscapes moved by winds, snowdrifts piled into heaps and valleys. In my work with paper, I use pattern, varying volumes, and topography along with surface reflection to recreate the light-and-shadow play and movement that occur in the beautiful phenomena of natural wave forms."
