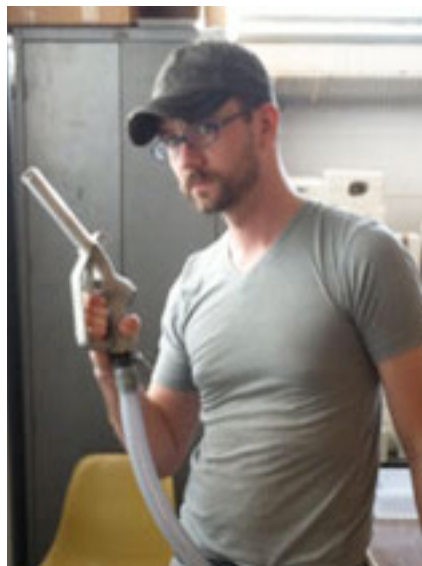


Jeremy Brooks



Jeremy Brooks is a ceramics artist, best known for his works of knit elastic clay. His original recipe results in a ceramic material that acts as flexible rubber, able to be rolled into thin coils and subject to traditional fiber techniques.

Honors include receiving the emerging artist award from the National Council on Education for the Ceramic Arts (NCECA), being selected as a guest of honor at the XXIst International Biennial of Vallauris, France, & being selected as a finalist for the 2017 Elizabeth R. Raphael Founder's Prize. Jeremy is currently an Assistant Professor of Ceramics at Coastal Carolina University and resides in Conway, SC.
