Matt Mitros is a ceramicist and sculptor born in Philadelphia, PA. Known for his unconventional cups and mugs, the artist blends a multitude of materials, familiar and foreign, challenging the conventional vessel. Each work demands interrogation of each individual component, ranging from stones to plexiglass to puddy, coming together to form a unique assemblage.

Mitros has held several prestigious residencies, including Arrowmont School of Arts & Crafts, the Archie Bray Foundation, the Red Lodge Clay Center, and The Residency of Paris, France. He has taught at the University of Washington, South Seattle Community College, Lakeside Upper School, Kennesaw State University, The University of Alabama, and currently is an Assistant Professor at Southern Illinois University.
