Zemer Peled is a ceramic artist, constructing forms made up of thousands of porcelain shards. Her sculptures pull inspiration from botanical growth, reminiscent of flower petals and coral reefs. By constructing spikes and aggressive forms out of delicate porcelain, Peled invokes the duality of nature and encompasses both the beauty and the brutality found in the wild.

Peled was born and raised in Israel. She earned her MA at the Royal College of Art (UK). In recent years, her work has been exhibited internationally at venues including Sotheby's, Saatchi Gallery (London), and the Nelson Atkins Museum of Art (Kansas City). She has been featured in Vogue, O Magazine, Elle, Ceramics Monthly, Colossal, Hi-Fructose, BBC News and other international publications.
