Ken Anderson is a Professor in the Department of Art and Art History at the University of Missouri, St. Louis. He received his M.F.A. in Painting from Southern Illinois University, Edwardsville in 1974 and his B.F.A. in Painting from Washington University in 1972. Anderson creates his work by combining various found materials—mostly man-made, distressed and patinated by nature's elements—with an intricate painting and assemblage process. His artistic intent has to do with transformation, rebirth, and discovery of beauty in the unexpected. Color and pattern play an important role in his paper works to create dynamic, energetic motion.
