Carol Crouppen Schuchard's photography draws from her experience working in collage, painting, fiber, and building renovation. A life-long collector, the artist assembles tableaux of found objects to be photographed, each with personal memories and connotations attached. Using careful considerations in her light and printing methods while juxtaposing subjects removed from context, the artist presents her photographs as mysterious shards of information.
